




Record Books Due

National 4-H Week

October 6-12, 2024

How is your club or your county program celebrating National 4-H Week?

4-H dates back to 1902, but National 4-H Week had its beginning during World War II. Following Pearl Harbor, it was decided to postpone the annual National 4-H Camp held in Washington, D.C. Soon after, 4-H leaders in Ohio announced their plans for a State 4-H Mobilization Week, focusing on what 4-H members could do for national defense. The idea was embraced by 4-H leaders nationwide and evolved into National 4-H Mobilization Week, observed in 1942, 1943 and 1944. In 1945, it became known as National 4-H Week and has been celebrated every year since.

This year, Wednesday, October 9, has been designated as Spirit Day, when 4-H members, alumni and volunteers are urged to wear 4-H attire. If you do not have a 4-H shirt or hat, you can wear green to show your support.

Leadership for Life

New Jersey 4-H members in grades 9-12 who

are members in good standing are invited to participate in a multilevel leadership program called the NJ 4-H *Leadership for Life Program*.

Adapted from Ireland's



Adapted from Ireland's youth development program Foróige,

the *Leadership for Life Program* is based on theories and principles of youth work, leadership development, and leadership styles.

Offered in three sequential modules, this program is aimed at equipping young people to explore their vision and passion and to develop such key skills as planning, decision-making, critical thinking, goal setting, and problemsolving.

Members must complete Modules 1 and 2 before they are eligible to complete Module 3. The Advanced Module is held during a 9-day travel experience to the Foróige Leadership for Life Conference at the University of Ireland in Maynooth, Ireland.

The Leadership for Life Program will be offered on the following dates during 2024–2025. Modules 1-3 will be held at the Mercer County Extension Office located at 1440 Parkside Avenue in Trenton.

Module 1: Saturday, January 11, 2025 10am-5pm

Module 2: Saturday, February 22, 2025 10am-5pm

Module 3: Saturday, March 15, 2025 10am-3pm

Module 4: 2026 University of Ireland at Maynooth

STEM Challenge - National 4-H Council

- Food Fighters: This collaborative board game gamifies learning about the global food supply chain. Students work together to secure their town's food supply, making strategic decisions and building teamwork skills.
- Chew on This: This entrepreneurial challenge encourages students to think critically about food waste reduction. By brainstorming innovative uses for food scraps, students develop problem-solving and design thinking skills.
- Know to Grow: This hands-on engineering activity introduces students to plant science and controlled environment agriculture. Students design and build efficient growing environments, fostering an understanding of plant cultivation and its role in food security.



4-H'ers become amateur zookeepers, assist zoo staff behind the scenes, and observe animal care sessions. In this learn-by-doing environment, members explore careers in the animal field and learn about animal conservation all while having fun in the park!

State 4-H Dairy Show


