



4-H Qualifying Show Results


Warren County hosted its first dual county qualifying horse show with Hunterdon County. 2 members from each county participated and qualified for the NJ State 4-H Horse Show.

Farm Camp

6 youth participated in Farm Camp! Teens from the Teen Council volunteered as camp counselors for the 2 day summer day camp. Day 1 was Fiber day and the youth learned about fiber animals such as alpaca, goats, and rabbits. Natalie and Mike Burger from Hidden Pastures Farm in Branchville brought the animals and taught the participants about the

fiber from each animal. Youth also made dreamcatchers with yarn and learned to finger knit a scarf!
